
From The Heart & Soul of The Pastor

DIVINE CONNECTION – I love people. Whenever GOD divinely connects me to other people, even remotely, I believe the relationship has purpose. Often the purpose of the relationship transcends my understanding and is not initially known nor seen but God knows everything. God told Abram to "get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will show thee." The scripture say in Genesis 12:4, "so Abram departed, as the Lord had spoken unto him: and Lot went with him..." The scripture speaks of Lot almost as an afterthought.

However as Lot journeyed with Abram, God prospered Lot simply because he dwelled with Abram. It matters who you associate with! The Lord had already pronounced a covenant blessing on Abram. He told Abram, I will bless them that bless thee, I will curse him that curseth thee. IN THEE shall all the families of the EARTH be blessed (Genesis 12).

Where you go in life is directly related to who you walk with; who you spend quality time with. Who do you allow to influence the way you think? Who do you listen to? Divine Connection:

Silas would have never known that he could sing praises to the Lord from a prison cell at midnight had his life not have intersected with Paul's (Acts 16:25). Lot acquired wealth that he would have never known had his life not been connected to Abram (Genesis 13:5-4). Joshua knew God as a God of supernatural signs and wonders because of His relationship with Moses. This is why he had the boldness to tell the sun to stand still while he defeated his enemies (Joshua 10:12-14). Elisha received a double portion because of his relationship with Elijah (2 Kings 2: 9-14). Pharaoh's kingdom prospered because of Joseph (Genesis 41:39-44). Joseph prospered because of Ishmael; his brothers sold Joseph to the Ishmaelite's (Genesis 37:28). It was the Ishmaelite's who sold Joseph into in Egypt (Genesis 39:1). The lie Potiphar's wife told on Joseph pushed him into his destiny; Pharaoh's Prison. It was in this prison where God gave him the interpretation of Pharaoh's dream. We would never have known who Lydia, Priscilla, Aquila, Apollo, Timothy and Titus were had their lives not been connected to Paul. Whether we understand it or not, divine connection orchestrated by God has a distinct purpose for our spiritual journey. The Prophet Isaiah said it like this, "there is no searching of the Lord's understanding" (Isaiah chapter 40:28).

July 2014

It's July 2014, the 7th month of the year 2014. What does this mean to you? Does it mean this year is halfway over or has it just begun? Did it only mean eating barbeque ribs and fireworks on the Fourth of July with family and friends? Or did you look at it in a whole different light?

In biblical scriptures numbers usually have a more symbolic significance than just their face value in individual number quantity. Although this is the month of July it is also the 7th month of the year. In scripture the number 7 is a very profound number it's symbolic of perfection and completion both spiritual and physical. It is the number of Covenant and of the Holy Spirit. In Genesis 2:1-3 the number 7 is first mention and symbolized as perfection, completion, and illustrates the mighty work of God. It is noted "on the Seventh day God ended his work which he had done and rested. Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it...." The number seven is also ideally illustrated as Joshua led the Israelites, with the Ark, around the city 7 times with 7 priests blowing 7 trumpets (Joshua 6:2-5). God made a promise to Noah in the sign of a rainbow, which consist of 7 colors, not to destroy the earth with flood again (Genesis 9:8). As the Bible uses 7 to indicated a perfection, 7 and 14 are inseparable throughout it. In Revelation 4 it notes God as having 7 spirits, depicted as 7 lampstand.

The number 14 is a double portion of spiritual perfection as it is a multiple of 7 x 2. It represents spiritual progression, righteousness, and deliverance. This can be seen as the world awaited the coming of Jesus as prophesied by the Old Testaments Prophets. The Virgin Mary was 14 years old when she was told about her conception of Jesus. The bloodline of Jesus is divided into 3 sets of 14 generations, Matthew 1:1 -17. The Passover is celebrated the 14th day of the first month, Ezra 6:19. Jacob worked 14 years for his uncle Laban in order to marry his daughter Rachel. The first seven years he allowed him to take Leah for his wife, the older sister of Rachel, and after the second of seven years, he finally married Rachel. Jacob had 14 sons and grandson, Genesis 29, 15-30 and 46:22.

Now let's look at the number 20. It represents a complete or perfect waiting period. It signify "expectancy". For 20 years Jacob waited to get possession of his wives and property, and to be freed from the control of Laban his father-in-law (Genesis 31:38 - 41). For 20 years the children of Israel waited to be freed of Jabin, king of Canaan, who oppressed them. God response was to raise up Deborah and Barak, who freed the people from bondage (Judges 4 - 5). Solomon spent seven years building the house of God in Jerusalem and another 13 building his own home for a total number of 20 years. After he had completed both buildings Solomon gave Hiram, the king of Tyre, twenty cities in the land of Galilee (1Kings 9:10 - 11).

Now I asked what does July 2014 (7/2014) means to you and for you? For in the season God is redeeming the times and releasing his Spirit in unusual measures within the land, as he bring the Nation to repentance. This is the year of double portion, release, and deliverance. Release from prisons whether it is spiritually, physically, or mentally; and deliverance from bondage of sin. "Just believe." Be blessed in Jesus name, Amen!!!
