"Somethin' from Sam"

As was mentioned at the beginning of the year, one of the great old hymns of the faith, written by Thomas Chisholm, is entitled, "Great is Thy Faithfulness". It is based on Lamentations 3:23, which is the theme verse for all of the messages this year. Chisholm wrote more than 1200 poems in his lifetime, many which later became hymns. He wrote "Great is Thy Faithfulness" in 1923 at the age of 57. When asked, at the age of 75, about the reasons why he wrote this very popular hymn, he responded with these words; "My income has not been large at any time due to impaired health in the earlier years which has followed me on until now. Although I must not fail to record here the unfailing faithfulness of a covenant-keeping God and that He has given me many wonderful displays of His providing care, for which I am filled with astonishing gratefulness." You see, Thomas Chisholm did not write this hymn because of something great, or even miraculous that had happened in his life. Rather, he wrote it because as he looked back over his life, he learned to see the great faithfulness of God; that He indeed could be trusted to carry out His promises! As we will learn this morning, Joshua was a man who also trusted in God's faithful promises. And those same promises that God gave to Joshua are promises that we can trust in today!

Praise God for His GREAT faithfulness!

Trusting in God's Promises: The Example of Joshua Joshua 1:1-9

God spent many years preparing Joshua for his role of taking the place of Moses as the leader of the nation of Israel (see Ex. 17:8; 24:12-13; Numbers 13-14; Deut. 31:7-8). Following the death of Moses Joshua faced one of the greatest challenges of his life. Although he knew that he was chosen by God to be the next leader, no doubt the reality of it all suddenly crashed in on him. God gave Joshua three assurances, and I believe that every child of God today needs to be aware of these assurances, for they help us to keep trusting in what God has promised.

I. GOD IS ALWAYS FAITHFUL IN HIS PROMISES!

A.	The particular promise that was at the forefront of Joshua's mind was the promise God had given to – Gen. 17:8; Joshua 1:1-2
В.	God is the Giver. He is the of our blessings. – Joshua 1:2c, 3
C.	It is in the very nature of God to give, whether it was the Promised Land to the Israelites, or salvation to each of us. – James 1:17
II. G	GOD IS ALWAYS FAITHFUL IN HIS PRESENCE!
A.	Note that God reassured Joshua, not once, but that He would be with him. – Joshua 1:5b, 9b
В.	We are bound to the heart of God by cords of Heb. 13:5b
C.	The scope of this assurance is that God is with you " you go." – Joshua 1:9b
III.GOD IS ALWAYS FAITHFUL IN HIS PRECEPTS (commands from His Word)!	
A.	God's commands were to be the guiding of Joshua's life so that he could do what God desired of him to do. – Joshua 1:7
В.	In Joshua 1:8, God told Joshua 3 ways to stay in the Word; 1. "Talk about it." 2. "about it" (that is what "meditate" means). 3. "DO IT!"
C.	Faith is not real until it is; as you commit your life to Jesus Christ, you WILL DO WHAT HE SAYS! — Luke 6:46

Faithfulness is the key. Sometimes you are going to get tired of the grind. You may feel like giving in, but you must remain faithful until the end. Are you being faithful and trusting in God's promises or is it possible that you've gotten off the path that God has called you to follow?

Q: Did Abraham have just one son?

A: Some have said the Bible must be in error when Abraham was told to sacrifice his son, because Scripture says it was his *only* son, Isaac, but that could not be true because of Isaac's older brother, Ishmael.

However, Hebrews 11:17 qualifies the "only son" concept for us. Isaac was the only *begotten* (i.e., unique, special) son of Abraham. Isaac was indeed unique and special in that he was the promised son through whom Jesus Christ, the Messiah, would come.

Similarly, Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of God, even though others are called the sons of God (such as Adam in Luke 3:38 and Christians in Galatians 3:26). Jesus is the only unique and special Son of God—God who became a man.

Additionally, the Hebrew word for "only" doesn't mean exactly what our English translation often conveys.
